

PAC-MAN TICKET MANIA - NAMCO EUROPE

BANDAI Namco Europe has released the latest of its Fun to Win redemption range; **Pac-Man Ticket Mania**, which combines the classic Pac-Man theme with new features.

Pac-Man Ticket Mania features a full colour LED marquee, which will display messages during attract mode and game play. The cabinet features a traditional four-way joystick with heavy-duty microswitches. The joystick itself is double the size of a standard Pac-Man joystick for higher visibility and ease of use. Pac-Man Ticket Mania has two fun celebration payout screens featuring familiar Pac-Man characters. One screen is for the standard ticket payouts and the other is for the Pac-Pot victory celebration payout. The object of the game is to get Pac-Man inside the Pac-Pot Chamber to win and collect points along the way by eating dots, fruits and frightened ghosts. The Pac-Pot has a rotating jackpot number that ranges from 100 up to 1,000. Whatever number is displayed on screen when Pac-Man enters the chamber is the number won. "The appeal of Pac-Man never seems to diminish and we have extremely high expectations of this latest themed redemption game," said Bandai Namco Europe commercial director John Brennan. "No matter what the age of the player, this game is bound to appeal and we have seen wonderful results on site."



BALLOON BUSTER - LAI GAMES AND AMG LEISURE

LAI Games has always been at the forefront of prize vending machines, paving the way with probably one of the most successful games ever, **Stacker**. 2013 has seen LAI Games once again return with a top performing machine, **Balloon Buster**. Much like **Stacker**, the game is designed to be easy to play. The play field consists of five balloons each of which has a prize hanging from them. The player has to line up a dart and get it through a hole in front of the balloon. If successful, the dart will burst the balloon and a prize will be vended. LAI has given the machine very bright artwork and a carnival theme. The attraction sounds are loud and appealing and the drum roll after the player lines the dart up adds to the tension. Since the game's introduction at the EAG show in London, there has been "a huge buzz around the industry" about **Balloon Buster**. The product is distributed exclusively in the UK by **AMG Leisure**.



FRUIT MANIA XTREME - UNIS

FIRST unveiled at the end of 2012, **Fruit Mania Xtreme** from **UNIS Games** has "captured the imagination everywhere," said **Steven Tan**, the company's general manager. The video style pusher machine means rapid shooting action without coins. Players have to aim and shoot coins at the rotating fruits to drain the health bars for the fruits to turn into treasure boxes and fall onto the platform. Tickets are won when coins and boxes drop into the Winning Zone or more tickets can be won if they instead drop into the Prize Wheel Trigger, with the chance to win special items.
